NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Contra Costa Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday**, **May 26**, **2010** at the LAFCO office located at 651 Pine Street, Sixth Floor, in Martinez, CA. The hearing is scheduled for 3:00 p.m.

The hearing will be conducted by the Commission's Executive Officer, who has been delegated the authority to conduct the hearing.

At the hearing, LAFCO will receive protests filed against the **Central Contra Costa Sanitary District (CCCSD) Annexation 173B**. This application was initiated by CCCSD to annex 100+ acres in eight separate annexation areas in the Town of Danville to the District. The purpose of the annexation is to extend sanitary sewer services to the annexation area.

How to file a Valid Protest: The hearing on May 26, 2010 is open to the public. To be considered valid, a protest must be written and filed by either landowners or registered voters within the annexation areas. Protests may either be mailed to the LAFCO office prior to the hearing, or submitted during the public hearing on May 26, 2010.

Only written protests **received prior to the conclusion of the hearing on May 26 will be counted.** Protests may either be mailed to Contra Costa LAFCO at 651 Pine Street, Sixth Floor, Martinez, CA 94553, or delivered to the LAFCO Executive Officer at the protest hearing. Each protest must be signed and dated, must state whether it is made by a landowner or a registered voter, and must include the name and address of the protestor and a street address or parcel number identifying the location of the land. A registered voter's protest must show the name and address appearing on the affidavit of registration. Any protest without a date, bearing a date prior to the date of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing shall be disregarded for the purposes of ascertaining the value of any written protest. Protests cannot be accepted by fax or email.
