Fiscal Year 2012-13 Budget and Work Program Schedule

Dear Members of the Commission:

The Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (CKH Act) creates a specific process for preparing and adopting LAFCO's budget. Government Code §56381 provides that the Commission shall adopt annually, following noticed public hearings, a proposed budget by May 1 and final budget by June 15. Contra Costa LAFCO typically adopts a proposed budget in March and a final budget in May each year.

In conjunction with a proposed budget, the Commission sets out a work plan in March each year. The work plan typically includes goals and objectives such as conducting the annual financial audit, updating the Commission's Handbook, initiating Municipal Service Reviews (MSRs)/Sphere of Influence (SOI) updates, and other projects.

In August 2011, the Commission conducted a strategic planning session. As part of the session, the Commission identified a number of priorities, including review of LAFCO terms and conditions, facilitating sustainable fire services including resolution of East County fire service issues, facilitating local government efficiencies and collaboration through reorganization (e.g., consolidation, dissolution), and facilitating island annexations. The Commission's February 8 agenda will include a discussion of island annexations.

One of the more significant projects involves MSRs/SOI updates. In 2006, the Commission adopted a MSR work plan that provides for preparing comprehensive MSRs. The majority of these include countywide and sub-regional MSRs, with several agency-specific reviews prepared on an as-needed basis (see attached MSR Schedule).

To date, countywide MSRs have been completed for the following services: healthcare, water and wastewater, fire/emergency medical, reclamation, cemetery, mosquito/vector control, park and recreation, resource conservation and police services. Also, sub-regional MSRs covering all 19 cities and community service districts (CSDs) are complete.

In FY 2011-12, LAFCO will complete the last of its inaugural MSRs (i.e., library and miscellaneous county service areas).

The CKH Act provides that on or before January 1, 2008, and every five years thereafter, LAFCO shall, as necessary, review and update the SOIs of each local agency. In accordance with the SOI updates, LAFCO shall conduct a municipal service review. FY 2012-13 marks the beginning of LAFCO's second round MSRs as determined by the Commission. In accordance with the MSR Schedule, those services that were reviewed at least five years ago include health care and water and wastewater services.

Should the Commission wish to initiate second round reviews on any of these services, it is recommended that LAFCO solicit the assistance of outside consultants through a Request for Proposal (RFP) process. In order to have cost estimates in time for the final budget adoption in May, an RFP process should be initiated in the near future.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Direct the staff to prepare the LAFCO budget and work plan for Fiscal Year 2012-13;
- 2. Direct staff to present a Proposed Budget for review and approval at the March 14, 2012 LAFCO meeting;
- 3. Direct staff to present a Final Budget for review and approval at the May 9, 2012 LAFCO meeting; and
- 4. Provide direction regarding second round MSRs and other matters as desired.
